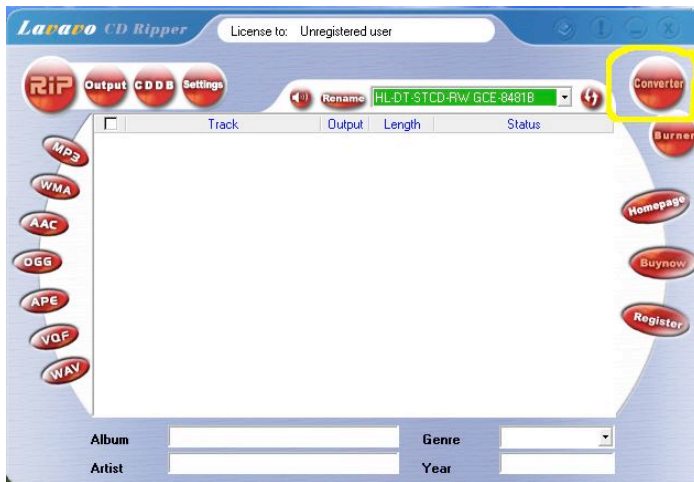


Convert most audio format files into .WAV

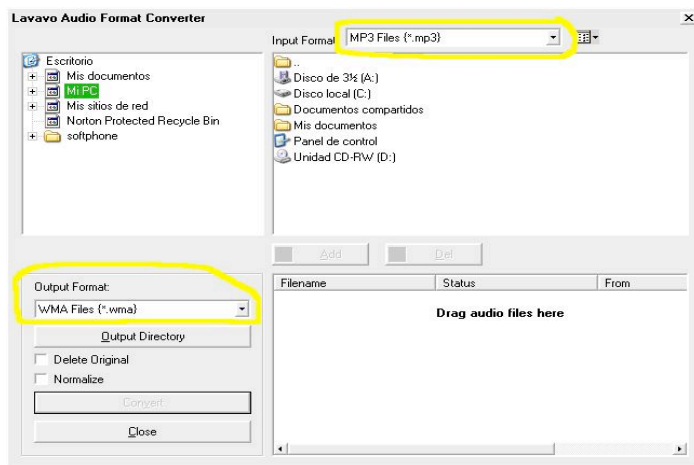
MCDI suggests using a shareware tool named Lavavo CD Ripper. You can download it from <http://www.lavavo.com>. This tool allows you to create sounds in .wav format from most valid sound format files. WAV is the only format supported by WINSAMM.

Download it from Lavavo's download page and install it on your hard disk. This is a shareware version, so all the functions are not included on it, but you can purchase the full one on line if you need more.

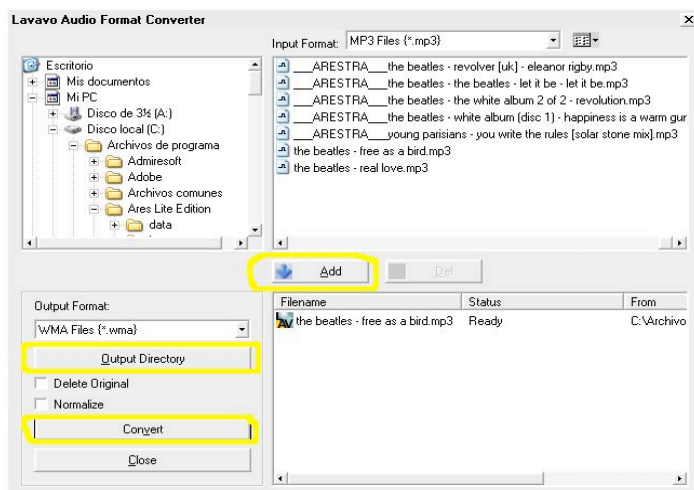
Creating a .wav file from another format



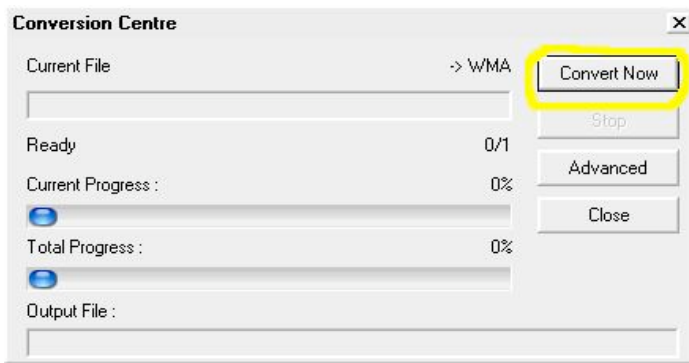
Select the conversion tool as indicated in colored icon.



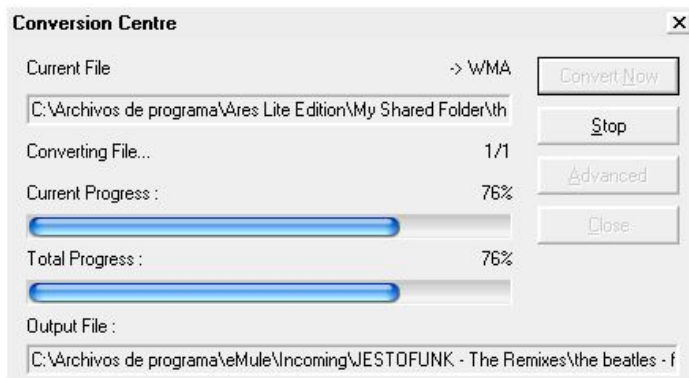
Choose the Input Format (original file format) and then, the Output Format (desired format to be converted). In this case .WAV.



Find the original sound file location with the explorer. Then click on ADD. To replace sounds directly, select the output directory SAMM>SOUDS. To finalize, click on Convert.



In this window, click on 'Convert Now' in order to start the sound file conversion.



The conversion process has started. Once completed, name your files according to the sound priority level you want to replace from P0sound.wav to P9sound.wav. Replace sound files in the directory samm>sounds. Restart WINSAMM.
